Optional Donation for Aquatic Invasive Species Reserve

The invasive species reserve fund is for prevention and treatment of aquatic invasive species (AIS). To date, Windigo is one of the few lakes in Sawyer County that is virtually AIS free. We historically funded boat landing monitoring with volunteer hours combined with a series of DNR grants. If AIS were found in Windigo, remediation efforts would need to be done quickly, and this fund is very important to have on hand.

Most recently, we have developed plans for a AIS decontamination system at the parking lot for the boat landing. This project is particularly useful because it is an active form of prevention (as compared to more passive educational programs). Also, Sawyer County has an ordinance with stiff penalties if boaters do not use a decontamination station when present. We have applied for a grant from the DNR for up to 75% funding of the project. If approved, we will need to fund project costs that are not covered by the grant. The project will require installation of electricity and a well for water. We have already received approval from the Town of Bass Lake for implementation of the system.

The Windigo Lake Fish and Wildlife Committee would like to take this opportunity to thank those who donated for your generosity. In the past, we have benefited from some DNR programs such as island tree drops and fish population surveys to efficiently use our funds. Going forward, the committee is looking into a number of alternative improvements that will positively impact our fish and wildlife for years to come. Many of the surrounding area lakes have already implemented a proactive comprehensive plan for protecting and maintaining their lakes fishery and wildlife. We hope to have this type of plan for our lakes in the near future. With this in mind, we hope you will consider donating to help with our lakes' health and well-being.
